Adrenocorticotropic hormone (ACTH) stimulates the adrenal glands to release cortisol. ACTH is a 39 aa peptide processed from precursor pro-opiomelanocortin (POMC) by specific enzymatic cleavages. Defects in POMC are a cause of obesity.

Format: Each vial contains 0.1 mg lgG in 0.1 ml (1 mg/ml) of PBS pH7.4 with 0.09% sodium azide. Antibody was purified
